**Film Series Continues with Film About Legendary Artist, Frida Kahlo
at the Ludington Area Center for the Arts**

LUDINGTON—The Third Coast Film Society at the Ludington Area Center for the Arts continues its monthly film series on Friday, May 28th at 7 p.m. with the Academy Award-winning film, *Frida*.

This biographical film captures the life of the legendary surrealist Mexican painter, Frida Kahlo. A sumptuous feast of art, music, art direction and outrageous personalities, *Frida* chronicles her long and stormy marriage to Mexican muralist Diego Rivera, and the circle of artists, celebrities, and famous figures who inhabited their world. With Academy awards for best makeup and best original music score, the film stars Salma Hayek as Frida and Alfred Molina as Diego Rivera. *Frida* is directed by noted theater, opera, and film director, Julie Taymor.

In the coming months, the Third Coast Film Society will continue screening films about artists: June's film will be *Vincent and Theo*, about Vincent Van Gogh and his art dealer brother, Theo. July's offering will be *Buena Vista Social Club* about legendary Cuban musicians, and in August, the Society screens, *Basquiat*, about the post-modern African American artist, Jean Michael Basquiat.

Tickets for each film screening are \$7 per person at the door. Popcorn and beverages will be available for sale.
