Greetings From...
An Exhibition of Postcard-Size Art at the Ludington Area Center for the Arts

LUDINGTON— The Ludington Area Center for the Arts presents, *Greetings From...* an exhibition of postcard-size artwork from August 3 through 21 in the main gallery. The public is invited to buy these original pieces of artwork for \$30 each at a public reception and sale Friday, August 6, from 6-8 p.m.

The show features 85 postcards from 22 artists from the Ludington area. In addition to watercolors and drawings, *Greetings From...* includes original work in mixed media, fiber, and even metal. Each artist brought their own personal flair to the show, creating a diverse collection of pint-sized works of art. One of the artists, Ruth B. Dimmitt, created mixed media postcards that encompass a 3-D element and leap out of the paper. Her piece, “Volcano,” stays true to its name by showing viewers a minimalist view of one of earth’s natural destroyers.

In addition to the *Greetings From...* exhibition, the Center for the Arts will be showcasing visual arts in many forms throughout August. Artist Emily Crowley’s portraits will share the gallery space with *Greetings From...* from August 13 through 29 and the Center’s gift shop is now open with original paintings, sculpture, pottery, jewelry, and cards by area and regional artists.
