**Film Series Continues with Film about Vincent Van Gogh  
at the Ludington Area Center for the Arts**

LUDINGTON—The Third Coast Film Society at the Ludington Area Center for the Arts continues its monthly film series on Friday, June 25 at 7 p.m. with *Vincent and Theo*.

Directed by Robert Altman, this is an unsentimental portrait of Vincent Van Gogh and his art dealer brother, Theo Van Gogh. Altman focuses on the symbiotic relationship between Vincent, who provides the living embodiment of Theo's unfulfilled artistic aspirations, and Theo, who tries to connect his brother to the outside world and financial independence. Focusing on the individual rather than his art, the film is a powerful interpretation of the life of one of the world's most famous artists. It stars Tim Roth as Vincent and Paul Rhys as Theo. This film is rated PG-13.

In the coming months, the Third Coast Film Society will continue screening films about artists: July's offering will be *Buena Vista Social Club* about legendary Cuban musicians, and in August, the Society screens, *Basquiat*, about the post-modern African American artist, Jean Michael Basquiat.

Tickets for each film screening are \$7 per person at the door. Popcorn and beverages will be available for sale.
